Sub: Reimbursement of OPD Medicines: Special Sanction in view of COVID-19

In continuation of the circular Ref No. GSO/HOSP/MS/COVID-19/2020/30th March, 2020 regarding reimbursement of OPD Medicines: Special Sanction in view of COVID-19.

1. Due to COVID lockdown in view of prevention of COVID-19 regular monthly medicine facility is extended for another one month as follows:


a) **CHENNAI AND OUTSTATION CHSS BENEFICIARY:**

Can purchase routine regular monthly medicine for dialysis and heart disease, blood pressure, cancer etc., with drug card/previous prescription for 2 months till 30th September, 2020. The medical claim shall be submitted within three months.

b) **CHSS BENEFICIARY RESIDING AT DAE TOWNSHIP KALPAKKAM AND ANUPURAM.**

Will get regular monthly medicine from **DAE Hospital Pharmacy Kalpakkam / Anupuram with drug card/previous prescription** maintaining social distance and mask usage to avoid possible exposure to prevent COVID-19. CHSS Beneficiaries can purchase medicine from outside pharmacies if not available at DAE Hospital Pharmacy Kalpakkam / Anupuram / outsourced Apollo Pharmacy with approval of MO Incharge Pharmacy / Medical Superintendent / Medical Superintendent - Incharge and the medical claim shall be submitted within two months.
