Sub: Reimbursement of OPD Medicines: Special Sanction in view of COVID-19

In view of the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19), all efforts are made by the Government to contain its impact by measures at community as well as at individual level.

1. Guidelines for maintaining home stay, social distancing between individuals have already been issued by the Government.
2. Majority of the hospital suspended their regular OPD service and only emergency service is in place. In the spirit of above guidelines CHSS beneficiaries are advised as follows:

a) CHENNAI AND OUTSTATION CHSS BENEFICIARY:


Can purchase routine regular monthly medicine for dialysis and heart disease, blood pressure, cancer etc., with drug card/previous prescription till 30th April, 2020 or further if nation wide lock down extended.

b) CHSS BENEFICIARY RESIDING AT DAE TOWNSHIP AND ANUPURAM.

Will get regular monthly medicine till 30.04.2020 from outsourced Apollo Pharmacy located at Kalpakkam and Anupuram with drug card/previous prescription without non-availability certificate from DAE Hospital Pharmacy to avoid possible exposure to prevent COVID-19. CHSS Beneficiaries can purchase medicine from outside pharmacies if not available at outsourced Apollo Pharmacy.

All are requested home stay and social distancing and frequent hand wash with soap/sanitiser to break the chain of COVID-19 and prevent the infection.
