CIRCULAR NO. 17/2020

Sub: Preventive measures to be taken to contain the spread of Novel Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) – regarding

Reference is invited to circular No. GSO/EMS/2020/676 dated April 8, 2020 on the above mentioned subject. The Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi have vide order dated 15.4.2020, further issued Consolidated Revised Guidelines on the lockdown measures for containment of COVID-19, which has been duly endorsed by DAE.

To ensure compliance of the directives, the following advisories are reiterated for strict compliance with immediate effect and until further orders:


1. Township gates will be closed for all vehicular and pedestrian movement, except duly authorised Departmental/Departmentally hired vehicles.
2. In order to adhere to the territorial jurisdiction restrictions imposed by the State Government of Tamil Nadu under Section 144 of CrPC and to implement the containment measures laid down by Ministry of Home Affairs, only private vehicles (two/four wheelers) with passes issued by the State Authorities/Incident Commander will be permitted to move out of the townships or enter the townships.
3. If the residents are moving out of the townships with their private vehicles (2/4 wheelers) without any valid reason the Police officials are authorised to take custody of their vehicles apart from levying fine for disobeying the rules.
4. Shops of the townships will be open from 0600 hours to 1400 hours or as per the instructions of the State Government. Township residents (Only one member per family) are advised to venture out only for purchase of essential commodities during the permitted time, duly following the social distancing norms. Senior members of the family and children should not venture out for any purpose. Other than this, only those who have curfew pass from District Administrative Authorities will be permitted to go out of the Townships if situation demands so.
5. Residents should not move around in the beaches, parks or at any other recreational facilities.
6. CISF flying squad will be patrolling in both the townships to ensure minimum movement of the residents.
7. In addition, members of Service Associations have been nominated as “Volunteers” to oversee strict compliance of the preventive measures and social distancing guidelines. Residents should appreciate the efforts being put in by such “Volunteers” in the interest of all and not disobey or quarrel with them.

8. Any person violating the above measures shall be deemed to have committed an offence punishable under Section 188 and other relevant section of IPC (45 of 1860). Such a person shall in addition be proceeded against as per the provisions of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and Section 51 to 60 of The Disaster Management Act, 2005.
9. All the advisories issued by this office for prevention of spread of COVID -19 vide our earlier circulars are hereby extended upto 3rd May, 2020 or until further instructions.

All are requested to cooperate and comply with the above and help in the endeavour to contain the spread of COVID-19.
