In continuation of circular No 195 dated: 13-08-2025, it is further clarified that,

- 1. In case the requirement of medicines prescribed by the treating doctors of the referral hospitals is more than 10 days, beneficiaries can get the prescription for the same from the Visiting Consultants at Chennai clinics or from any of the AMAs for the remaining number of days exceeding 10 days and submit the prescription to the IMSc/Pallavaram clinics.
- 2. Drug Card entry is must for regular medicines. A copy of Drug Card is to be enclosed with the prescription.
- 3. The out sourced pharmacy representative will collect the prescription on alternate days from the IMSc/Pallavaram clinics and courier the medicines directly to the beneficiaries.
