Sub: Availing treatment for COVID-19 due to medical emergency – Reimbursement of medical expenses – regarding

Due to the ongoing spread of Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) and the prevailing pandemic situation, the CHSS beneficiaries residing outside Kalpakkam/Anupuram areas are facing problems to approach DAE Hospital/Dispensary at Kalpakkam and Anupuram respectively. Thus to avoid any hardship to the CHSS beneficiaries residing at outside places in getting immediate medical treatment for COVID 19 positive case, it has been decided to consider the COVID-19 treatment to be availed by the CHSS beneficiaries directly from the authorized Private Hospital as medical emergency treatment as per the provisions under CHSS Rules 1998. In this connection, the following rates fixed for treatment of COVID-19 for General Public in private Hospitals as per Hospital grade as indicated in the G.O.(Ms) No.240 dated 05/06/2020 issued by Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Tamil Nadu, will be reimbursable subject to the ceiling amount or bill amount whichever is less:

Treatment	Cost fixed for A1 and A2 grade private hospitals	Cost fixed for A3 to A6 private hospitals
Non critical COVID-19 cases	Rs.7500/- per day	Rs.5000/- per day
Critical care COVID-19 cases (inclusive of Ventilator if required)	Rs.15000/- per day	Rs.15000/- per day

The above rates are applicable till specific order if any to be issued by the Government of India for the Central Government servants or by DAE on the subject. CHSS beneficiaries, who may avail the COVID 19 treatment directly, are requested to note the following points:

 COVID 19 treatment is to be availed at authorized Private Hospital only within India and a proof/certificate from the concerned Hospital is to be furnished with Hospital grade.

- Intimation on availing of the COVID 19 treatment is to be furnished within 4 days from the date of commencement of the treatment to the DAE Hospital, Kalpakkam with details of CHSS beneficiary.
- Reimbursement shall be claimed in the prescribed application form (LES form) and to be submitted with original bills/receipts etc. along with a certificate from the concerned Private Hospital on the COVID 19 treatment provided to the CHSS beneficiary, to the CHSS Office, DAE Hospital, Kalpakkam for consideration.
- In case of retired beneficiaries, Bank Account Number and IFS Code shall be indicated in the reimbursement claim without fail. The validity of the CHSS card may also be indicated.
- 5. Except during inpatient treatment, no reimbursement will be allowed for COVID 19 testing charges if taken on their own by the CHSS beneficiary.
