OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Reconstitution of Kalpakkam Management Committee (KMC)

1. In supersession of all earlier orders on the subject, the Kalpakkam Management Committee (KMC) is reconstituted as follows with immediate effect.

1.	Director, IGCAR/GSO	Chairman
2.	Station Director, MAPS	Member
3.	Chairman and Managing Director, BHAVINI	Member
4.	Facility Director, BARC Facilities, Kalpakkam	Member
5.	Joint Secretary (Administration &Accounts), DAE	Member
6.	IFA, GSO	Member
7.	Member Secretary, HLSC	Member
8.	Director(P&A)/CAO, GSO	Member Secretary

2. Chairman, KMC can co-opt any other member as required. Only members shall attend the meeting.
3. The terms of reference of the KMC will be as under:
- To review and finalise plan for utilisation of DAE lands in Kalpakkam/Anupuram.
 - To constitute and administer Kalpakkam & Neighbourhood Development Fund. The fund will be created from the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds of the PSUs and sanction from the DAE.

- (iii) To consider and decide on the recommendations of the Township Amenities Committee and the Neighbourhood Development Committee.
 - (iv) To approve allotment of land/buildings to nationalized banks /Employees Co-operative Society/Govt. Schools including Special Schools at Kalpakkam/Anupuram and fixation and renewal of rent/lease as per extant rules.
 - (v) To approve / renew lease for allotment of departmental residential accommodation to non-DAE employees belonging to Central/State Govt. Organisations.
 - (vi) To consider the recommendations of High-Level Security Committee, Kalpakkam Emergency Committee, Disaster Management Committee and other agencies for strengthening the safety, security and disaster (natural and radiological) management of DAE installations and townships.
 - (vii) To decide on any other common issues for the smooth functioning of DAE Units / PSUs at Kalpakkam without any financial implications for improving the quality of life of the residents of DAE townships at Kalpakkam and Anupuram.
 - (viii) The Committee shall meet as often as necessary, at least once in a quarter.
4. KMC's decision should be within the guidelines of Government of India issued from time to time.
5. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
