02. DoPT vide OM No. F.No. 43019/9/2019-Estt.(D) dated 23/08/2021 advised the Department to devise their own point based merit system for assessing the merit of the claims of compassionate appointment and to bring in more transparency and probity in the system in processing the claims of Compassionate Appointment. Department of Atomic Energy vide OM No. 24/6/2014-SCS/6040 dated 06-05-2022 and OM No. 24/07/2024-SCS/15488 dated 29-10-2024 have formulated Relative Merit Point on 100 point scale to be adopted uniformly in all the DAE Units in accordance with DoPT OM. F No. 14014/1/2022-Estt.(D) dated 02.08.2022.

03. In light of the above guidelines, the Committee evaluated Seven (07) applications as per guidelines in OM dated 29-10-2024 and in which two cases were carried forward from previous meeting held on 18-07-2025, four were fresh cases and one case, where a representation was received on the merit points awarded in the meeting held on 18-07-2025 for Compassionate Appointment. The Committee perused the information furnished by the Applicants on financial condition of the family, assets and liabilities, earning family member, number of children etc., and certification obtained on loans/liabilities from Banks, Consumer Societies, Employees Co-operative Societies and Housing Finance firms.
