### **About READIT Conference Series**

Scientific Information Networking Division (SIND) of Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research(IGCAR), Kalpakkam and Madras Library Association – Kalpakkam Chapter(MALA-KC) have been conducting a series of biennial national conferences on Recent Advances in Information Technology (READIT) since 1995. The earlier 13 READIT conferences conducted were well received by professionals engaged in IT and Library Science from R&D and Academic Institutions from various parts of the country. It is now proposed to conduct a two day 14<sup>h</sup> READIT national conference series with a theme of "Envisaging the Libraries in the Coming Decades".

### About us

IGCAR was established in the year 1971, under the Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India . The centre is engaged in broad based multidisciplinary programme of scientific research and advanced engineering directed towards the development of Fast Breeder Reactor technology. The Library at the Centre was born in 1972, when the Centre was very young. It started with three thousand books and subscription to a dozen of journal titles. The Library at IGCAR has grown into its present stature of "Scientific and Information Networking Division" from being "Library and Documentation Services" and later on "Scientific Information Resources Division". In line with the metamorphosis, the services offered have also multiplexed in quality and quantity over the past three and a half decades. What started in the conventional way assumed the mantle of information service, which moved on to computer based automated services and today it has matured into a digital world and a knowledge resource hub with relevant information available at the click of the mouse.

Today, SIND is one of the most modern information resource centers in India. This is achieved by constantly enhancing and modernizing the digital library infrastructure and services. Excellent infrastructural facilities like advanced digital library servers, storages solutions, content creation facilities, enhanced e-resources, RFID based library management, are available in addition to conventional library services.

## **Objective:**

READIT targets professionals in the field of Information Technology, Library and Knowledge Management. It provides a forum for discussion and information access and Knowledge transfer in libraries. #### Venue:

The Conference will be held at IGCAR, Kalpakkam, which is located 75 km south of Chennai, the Capital of Tamil Nadu. It is also 10 km south of Mamallapuram, a fabulous South Indian tourist spot which is famous for architecture and sculpture skills of *Pallava Dynasty*. Kalpakkam is well connected by road and situated in the middle of Chennai to Puducherry ECR scenic beauty highway and surrounded by temple cities like Kancheepuram & Thirukazhukundram and Vedanthankal bird sanctuary

### How to reach?

It takes about 2 hours to reach Kalpakkam from Chennai by State Transport Bus and about 1:30 hours by Taxi. All north bound trains are terminated at Chennai Central Railway Station and south bound trains at Egmore Railway Station.

After acceptance by our editorial committee, the full papers should be sent on or before September 10, 2025. The author guidelines for full paper formatting will be communicated to individual authors upon the acceptance of their full papers.
